

Senior Traffic Operations Project Managers

The PTC operates a 552-mile system used by 194 million vehicles a year. The **Senior Traffic Operations Project Manager** is responsible for the efficient movement of traffic and goods throughout the PTC highway system, such as; work zone management, incident and emergency response, winter operations and operational planning. Together, we are building the highway of the future!

Responsibilities

- Leads and performs duties in the planning, location, design, and construction of Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) other engineering projects or systems integration. Coordinates, develops and reviews plans, specifications, and details for TM&O construction projects. Leads the implementation and maintenance of the ITS device asset management program.
- Leads the development and evaluation of mobility related performance measures and coordinates the use of mobility analytical software tools. Communicates system performance issues and mobility needs to superiors and cross departmental entities.
- Leads the implementation of the TM&O program with internal stakeholders, external agencies and private companies such as authorized service providers and hazardous material spill responders.
- Coordinates and communicates the development, implementation, and evaluation of the application of congestion mitigating strategies and highway operations during planned and unplanned events, incidents and emergencies.

Qualifications

- Bachelor's degree with major course work in transportation planning, public administration/safety, civil engineering, electrical engineering, systems engineering, computer science, data management/business intelligence, communications/traveler information or other related disciplines.
- Ten (10) years of experience in transportation systems management and operations experience which includes any of the following areas: transportation planning, traffic engineering, traffic operations, intelligent transportation systems, systems engineering, business analytics/data management, weather management, traveler information, traffic incident management or other related experience.
 - Possession of a valid Professional Engineer (PE) license issued by the Pennsylvania State Registration Board for Professional Engineers may be used as a substitute for four (4) years of experience.

Location

The position is located at the PTC's headquarters in Middletown, PA, right outside of Pennsylvania's capital city. The Central PA region has plenty to offer from picturesque scenery to premier entertainment, while residents enjoy an affordable cost of living. It is conveniently located within a few hours' drive of popular metropolitan areas such as Baltimore, Pittsburgh, Washington D.C. and New York City. *There is a Pennsylvania residency requirement, which must be fulfilled within six months of employment.*
