



GERARD M. EBBECKE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Mid-Atlantic Section of the Institute of Transportation Engineers (MASITE) will award at least one scholarship in the amount of **\$1500** for the **Fall 2009 semester**. To be eligible, you must be a **student member of ITE**.

Mr. Ebbecke was a traffic engineer, member of ITE and MASITE, and a registered Professional Engineer in Pennsylvania. He rose from entry-level engineer to Chief Traffic Engineer during his 28 years with the City of Philadelphia Traffic Engineering Division. Until his untimely death in December 1998, Mr. Ebbecke was a consummate transportation official within the region. Mr. Ebbecke's credentials included a Bachelor of Science degree from Villanova and two Master of Science degrees from Drexel University.

Who is eligible? Any full-time student enrolled in a four-year college program leading to a Bachelor's degree in Civil Engineering, with a concentration in Transportation Engineering, with an expected graduation of no earlier than December 2009. **The applicant must be a student member of ITE and must maintain at least a 2.5 grade point average.** The candidates may be called for an interview with the MASITE Scholarship Committee. No scholarship will be awarded to any student currently receiving 70% or more in tuition aid from other scholarships. Students who are not awarded a scholarship may reapply each year they are eligible.

Write a one-page essay on "What is the biggest challenge facing Transportation Engineers of the future and how would you address that challenge?" and attach this to your application. A Faculty Advisor must also sign the application (Page 2).
